- Public Safety Update
 - GRPD
 - Rash of shootings and fire-bombings; making progress in the investigations
 - Prostitution crackdown is showing successes; restraining orders against those picked up so they can't come onto W. Leonard; most of this activity these days is internet based
 - Nothing else really major happening
 - Wishing speedy healing to Officer Leonard for his MBB injury
- Neighborhood Business Alliance (NBA) Update AnnetteV
 - NBA is our 'umbrella' organization
 - Annette attended the July quarterly meeting on behalf of WLBA
 - NBA sponsored a great Business Expo this year
 - As well as the Grandwich competition
 - 30th Annual Neighborhood Business Awards November 7
 - Great affair; good complimentary food and beverage
 - Great awards program hosted by our Mayor and well-attended by prominent GR people
 - Several West Side nominations this year for awards
- Project One/Art Prize AnnetteV
 - West Side Street fair was held this past weekend on Bridge St. as part of this
 - W. Leonard District was well-represented
 - WGNO ran the beer tent and actually made money this year
- West Grand Neighborhood Organization AnnetteV
 - Will relocate offices to 754 W. Leonard later in the year
 - Temporarily at 666 W. Leonard in 'donated' quarters
 - Block Party; September 28; held at 455 W. Leonard

- lots of wonderful sponsors, including WLBA; Nature's Releaf is the headliner sponsor
- Silent Observer and others will be present
- Just received approval for a \$62,000 grant from the Auto Theft Prevention program
- City will be bringing CPTED training to GR; WGNO will get 2 or 3 staff trained and qualified
- WestSide Corridor Improvement Authority (CIA) Update JohnnyB
 - Good funding accumulated in the 'bank' right now, enabling the CIA to do bigger things
 - Façade Improvement Grant is one of those
 - Information on the CIA's page on the GRCity website
 - If you need more information on this, you can contact Dan Grinwis
 - Available to businesses in our District
 - Meet the first Friday of each month (generally), currently at Brann's, at 9am; public is welcome
 - Have a trash can project going for businesses; if you have question on that you can contact Pete
 Brand from Stockbridge
 - Will be working on wayfinding signage, and gateway signage with consistent branding, along with banners on poles
 - This information was well-received by those present
- Old Business
 - Treasurer Position at WLBA is vacant and needs to be filled
 - Johnny will touch base with a couple of our District banks
 - Anyone interested is invited to step up
- New/Other Business
 - Concerns being investigated about marijuana gifting occurring in head shops in the City in preparation for recreational
 - West Side Mural Maintenance
 - New mural on the side of the Shade Shop; paint peeling along the top
 - Annette is in conversation with George, the artist, who was supposed to seal the finished work but apparently did not
 - Did we purchase a maintenance program with that for 5 years?
 - Annette will report back
 - Tree Plantings on Seward impacting the pedestrian sidewalks; hazard
 - Reported by Dan Hickey of Fence Consultants on Seward BW
 - Annette saw this earlier as part of one of their neighborhood 'looksees' and is in conversation
 with the City via 311 and in conversations with our 1st Ward Commissioners Reppart and
 O'Connor
 - BTW: 311, which is the 'clearinghouse' for all things GRCity is a great resource for concerns and complaints; you are encouraged to make it your first call
 - These are apparently from an earlier planting before they discovered types of trees that are less sidewalk unfriendly
 - This will be addressed by the City but it could be Spring before it's done
 - It is the City's responsibility
 - Annette will circle back and let us know if she has further information
 - Nature's Releaf Steve Goff
 - Will go before the Planning Commission on October 10 for approval to provide medical marijuana in the current location of Shakedown St. at 670 Leonard NW
 - Shakedown St. will move into an adjacent building
 - Michigan company from the eastside of the state with a facility in Burton, MI
 - Fully licensed by the State
 - 3 local partners; not involved in operations
 - Will be leasing
 - Will begin buildout once approval is given

- Strong focus on employee safety and safety of assets and cash; very high level of security
- Excited to be locating on GR's West Side
 - Contribute to the community
 - WGNO has already benefitted
- Have a banking relationship; federal illegal
- Open first part of next year hopefully
- Shortage of product in the market is impacting everyone
